THE BERECO GROUP

Bereco began in 2003. 22 years on and we are still going strong and extremely proud to have over this time established one of the most recognised high quality, high performance and what we feel is the most environmentally friendly window and door brand in the UK.

The Bereco group was formed in 2005 and comprises of now two companies; Bereco Ltd supplying housebuilders and developers operating in the newbuild market and Bereco Retail Ltd that supplies home improvement businesses and direct sales to the domestic market.

The Bereco group now employs 26 sales, design and marketing team members at our distribution centre in Rotherham South Yorkshire, and there are a further 260 employees in manufacturing at our dedicated joinery centres in Poland.



OUR WINDOWS DON'T CO2T THE EARTH

In the last 20 years, Bereco have supplied over 261,000 wooden windows and doors saving in excess of 66 million kgCO2e* being emitted into our atmosphere, the equivalent of taking over 22,000 cars off our roads.

REDUCING YOUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

300 billion tons of carbon are stored in our forests across the world. When harvested to make wooden windows and doors, the wood retains the carbon store, making them carbon negative. You can reduce your carbon footprint by 160kgs CO2e* for every Bereco timber window and door you buy rather than a uPVC window or door.

HELPING THE WORLDS FORESTS TO GROW

Bereco make a conscious choice to supply our wooden windows and doors made from nothing but FSC® 100% or 100% PEFC Certifled timber. This ensures that our products help in the fight against deforestation.

INVEST IN YOUR HOME

Timber windows have the lowest lifetime cost in comparison to uPVC windows, with a life expectancy of around 60 years compared to just 25-35 years* from uPVC.

ENERGY EFFICIENT

Our energy saving window and doors are designed with optimum energy efficiency in mind. Timber is an excellent insulator and we utilise high-performance glazing and weather seals, giving U-values that are up to 35% bettern than the current building regulations.

YOUR HEALTH AND WELLBEING

With exposure to noise over long periods of time being been linked to health issues such as heart disease and dementia the noise rating should not be overlooked. Our windows with 24mm double glazing offer a sound reduction of 33dB and our specially designed acoustic double glazed units offer sound reduction of up to 42dB, ideal for properties with traffic noise or that are close to an airport.


All Bereco timber windows and doors come with a manufacturer's warranty. We are so confident in the guality of our windows and doors and our factory finishing that we give a warranty on our timber for 30 years and even offer a 10 year warranty against defects in manufacturing and factory finishes.

GUARANTEED LEAD TIMES

We guarantee delivery of our wooden windows and doors in 6-8 weeks all year round. Our state of the art production facility is supported by a dedicated sawmill with timber lamination line and glass plant manufacturing our more common types of sealed units, ensuring we are in complete control of the key elements needed to meet the deadlines of our customers.



OUR SUSTAINABILITY STORY

2003 - 2007

- Our first Environmental Policy was established.
- Our FSC® chain of custody is established from forest to factory and we deliver our first FSC® certified wooden windows and doors.
- We introduced our self-sufficient sawmill, using waste timber to produce our own FSC® pallets.
- We became founding members of the Wood Window Alliance and worked with the BWF and Wood for Good to promote timber as a sustainable construction material

2008 - 2012

- Our Heritage range with narrow cavity SlimLine glazing is launched for architecturally sensitive projects;
- We introduced our range of timber triple glazed windows and doors capable of meeting Passivhaus standards with u values as low as 0.8W/m²K.
- We become the only manufacturer in the UK supplying our windows manufactured from only FSC® 100% certified timber.

2013 - 2017

- Bereco sales and estimating offices became fully paperless, with all quotations and correspondence completed via email.
- Heriot-Watt University completed life analysis of timber windows on behalf of the WWA, proving engineered timber windows have a service life of 60 years and over.
- We joined the Alliance for Sustainable Building Products as a patron and undertake the first Environmental Product Declaration (EPD) of our sash windows, the first in the UK.

2018 - 2022

- We launched our extensive range of 1.3 W/m²K U-value windows and doors to help customers who are building and developing to achieve the new national building targets.
- We reduced our carbon emissions with our advanced production facilities which are powered by the sun. The 3687m² installation of solar panels will reduce our carbon emissions by an incredible 580 tonnes each year.
- We made changes so that we could power our offices with 100% renewable energy.

2022 - 2025

- We became one of the first UK timber window & door manufacturers to have our product U-values independently assessed and certified by a UKASaccredited body, the British Fenestration Rating Council (BFRC). This means our performance figures are verified to the latest BS EN ISO 10077-1:2017 standard, providing transparency and reliability.
- We became 100% PEFC Certified, expanding our supply chain of certified timber with a full chain of custody.
- We saved a total of 303 acres of endangered habitat through our partnership with World Land Trust and their Buy an Acre Scheme

AT THE FOREST Planting, Growing & Harvesting

Bereco use only FSC® 100% certified or 100% PEFC Certified wood. By buying our timber windows and doors you are helping to promote growth of the forest in Europe and worldwide and are protecting our planet from deforestation and climate change.

Foresters harvest timber in accordance forest management plans. A properly managed forest can take up to 130 years before it's ready for felling and harvesting.

- Years 90-130 Harvesting & Felling




AT THE SAWMILL Milling, Drying & Laminating









OUR TIMBER TYPES

Fully Certified Timber

All our timber is obtained from well managed forests with either FSC®100% or 100% PEFC Certification, with full Chain of Custody.

Softwood. Redwood

All our redwood is slow grown from Europe and harvested at between 90 and 130 years of age. It features a smooth surface, has a high proportion of heartwood; small knots and achieves excellent durability even without preservative treatment. Perfect for painted finishes.

Hardwood, Dark Red Meranti

Our hardwood comes with full chain of custody. It features a pitted effect surface and a natural red hue to the timber perfect for stain finishes.

Both softwood and hardwood come with the same 30 year warranty against rot and fungal infection and 10 year warranty on the factory applied coatings.
